


#### **READING** Isaiah 43:1-7

#### **\*GOSPEL** Luke 3:15-17, 21-22

The Gospel according to Luke **Glory to you, O Lord!** 

<sup>15</sup> As the people were filled with expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Messiah, <sup>16</sup> John answered all of them by saying, "I baptize you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the thong of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. <sup>17</sup> His winnowing fork is in his hand, to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his granary; but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire." <sup>21</sup> Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heaven was opened, <sup>22</sup> and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased."

#### **SERMON**



#### \*APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Be present with those who are isolated, alone, or homebound, especially Kathy and Dolores. Accompany individuals and families affected by addiction or mental health challenges. Uphold each person as your beloved. God of grace,

You draw us into community. Embolden ministries of racial reconciliation, nurture work on behalf of immigrants and refugees, and equip each to use their gifts for the sake of neighbors near and far. God of grace, **hear our prayer.** 

You equip your servants to be faithful disciples of Jesus. Be with our confirmation students, especially Brooklyn as she seeks to grow in her discipleship, and guide her family that together they may reflect your love and grace. God of grace, hear our prayer.


#### \*INVITATION TO COMMUNION


#### \*SENDING OF HOME COMMUNION
